One more possibility

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I disagree with much of what gets advocated in the name of Christianity, but there they had a good practice. They just kept it too small, limiting it to their little in-group. We should do it on a humanity-wide scale.

Let's each do the work we can and want to do, make the fruits of our labor freely available to everyone, take turns doing the work we agree needs doing but not enough people want to do, and sort out the details through discussion.

Such a solidarity economy avoids exchange and its problems: inequality, poverty, oppression, oligarchy, autocracy, etc. Plus it fits well with the ways we humans generally treat each other in our closest relationships. Strategy Note 323, 8 July 2025

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
